Applications are invited from the eligible Indian citizen as defined in Article 5 to 8 of the Constitution of India and permanent residents of Assam for filling up 7600 vacant posts of 13 Graduate Teachers (Arts), 25 Graduate Teacher (Science), 13 Graduate Teacher (Hindi) and 4 Graduate Teacher (Hindi) in the Directorate of Secondary Education, Assam in the scale of pay of Rs.14,000/- to 70,000/- including Grade Pay of Rs. 8,700/- PM (under pay band 1) plus other allowances as admissible under rules.

The District-wise, subject-wise, medium-wise and category-wise posts details as well as date and time of receipt of online applications and other details will be notified in the official website at www.mdyhsa-assam.gov.in in due course of time. Vacancies may vary due to administrative reasons. The Director of Secondary Education, Assam reserves the right to make changes in sequence of the recruitment process after publication of this advertisement. The Director of Secondary Education, Assam reserves the right to cancel or postpone the recruitment at any stage without assigning any reason.

The applying candidates must be ready to serve in their respective places of posting.

In terms of choice of their Districts.

CONDITIONS OF RECRUITMENT

(A) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Arts & Science).

- For the post of Graduate Teacher (Arts), the candidate must be Arts / Commerce Graduate or Post Graduate in Arts / Commerce having from recognized University with at least 50% marks in either Graduate or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution(s).
- For the post of Graduate Teacher (Science), the candidate must be Science Graduate or Post Graduate in Science having from recognized University with at least 50% marks in either Graduate or Post Graduation (or its equivalent) and Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) from National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution(s).
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE-238/2014/213, dttd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KKHISOU, IGNOU, IDOL, under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.

In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST/PS, ST/HS and PwD category.

(B) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Hindi).

- Prevent 7 Kame in Hindi with 50% marks and degree qualification with 50% marks or post Graduate degree in Arts with 50% marks from any recognized University.
Or
BA with 50% marks and having Hindi as one of the subjects with 50% marks or post Graduate degree in Arts with 50% marks provided that he has passed BA with one of the subjects as Hindi with 50% marks in Hindi.
- B.T. / B.Ed. degree from any recognized University (PARANGA) to be treated as B.Ed. degree only for the purpose of Hindi teaching.
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE-238/2014/213, dttd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KKHISOU, IGNOU, IDOL, under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.

In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST/PS, ST/HS and PwD category.

(C) Minimum educational and professional qualifications for direct recruitment in the post of Graduate Teacher (Sanskrit).

- Shastri with 50% marks and having degree qualification with 50% marks or post Graduate degree in Arts with 50% marks from any recognized University.
Or
BA with 50% marks and having Sanskrit as one of the subjects with 50% of mark or Post Graduate Degree in Arts with 50% marks in Sanskrit.
- B.T. / B.Ed. degree from any recognized University.
- In pursuance of the Govt. OM No. ASE-238/2014/213, dttd. 22.11.2019, those institutions having territorial jurisdiction outside the State of Assam but having a study centre in the State and such study centres if not recognized by DEC under UGC, the degrees / certificates issued by such off campus institutions shall not be considered as valid for the purpose of employment under Education Department. However, degrees / diplomas conferred by KKHISOU, IGNOU, IDOL, under Gauhati University and Distance Education under Dibrugarh University shall be considered as valid for the purpose of employment.
- In respect of Secondary TET Candidate must obtain 60% marks in each paper for UR category and 55% marks for OBC/MOBC, SC, ST/PS, ST/HS and PwD category.

In addition to the academic and professional qualification as prescribed in (A), (B) and (C) of this advertisement, the candidate must satisfy the following criteria:

- In case of Assamese Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Assamese Language as one of the subjects or have Diploma in Assamese Language issued by the Assam Sahitya Sabha or read up to HSLC level in Assamese medium School.
- (B) In case of English Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent examination with Bengali language as one of the subjects or have Diploma in Bengali language issued by the Bank, University, Bangiya Sahitya O Sanskrit Sammilan or read up to HSLC level in Bengali medium School.
- (C) In case of Hindi medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Hindi language as one of the subjects or read up to HSLC level in Hindi medium School.
- (D) In case of Hodo Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Hodo language as one of the subjects or read up to HSLC level in Hodo Medium School.
- (E) In case of English Medium School, the candidate must have passed HSLC or equivalent Examination with Alternative English as one of the subjects or read from Class XI onwards in English Medium School.

Provided that for recruitment of teacher for teaching ME, subject, 14 candidate who passed HSLC examination with particular ME subject shall be considered.

(d) Criteria for Selection of Graduate Teacher (Arts and Science)

- 100 marks on percentage of marks in BA/B.Com/B.Sc. examination. Major/Minor, the marks obtained in Major/Minor shall be taken into consideration.
 - 100 marks on percentage of marks in H.S. final examination.
 - 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination or 60 marks for 15 years of experience as an undergraduate/junior teacher in a provincialized High/Higer Secondary school having requisite academic and professional qualification. Any experience teacher who has appeared but could not secure the minimum qualifying 60 marks in the TET, shall be awarded at least 60 marks in respect of their experience. If he or she has already completed 15 years of teaching experience, Any marks secured by such experienced teacher other than above 60 qualifying marks in TET shall be counted additionally in respect of TET for such teacher.
 - Explanation: For the purpose of calculation of marks under the categories mentioned in clauses (III), (IV) and (V) above it may be clarified that if a candidate scores, for example 60% marks in the particular examination he/she secure 60 marks out of 100 marks allotted in the concerned examination.
 - 80 marks @ 28 marks for one year of teaching experience as contractual teacher and another 28 marks for two years, subject to consideration for a minimum period of two years.
- The Rule 10 (3) of the Assam Secondary Education (Provincialized Schools) Service Rules, 2018 (insertion) that:-
"The teachers engaged on contractual basis in a provincialized Higher Secondary / High school under the Scheme 'restructuring of secondary education' shall be given preference for recruitment to the post of Graduate Teacher by awarding total 30 marks for their services as contractual teachers, i.e. 28 marks for one year and another 28 marks for completion of two years of service as contractual teachers, subject to consideration for maximum period of two years."
- 50 marks teaching experience for the teachers working continuously on fixed pay basis (other than contractual teachers) in a provincialized Higher Secondary School or High School/Institution for their services as fixed pay teachers provided they have requisite academic and professional qualification.
 - 10 marks for NCC certificate (10 marks for "C" certificate and 5 marks for "B" certificate).
 - 10 marks for participating in recognized sports at national level representing Assam.
 - 10 marks for achievements in the Arts and cultural activities representing the State officially at National level.

(e) Criteria for Selection (1) Graduate Teacher (Hindi) and (2) Graduate Teacher (Sanskrit).

- 100 marks on percentage of marks in BA Examination with the concerning language as one of the subjects or highest degree in the language i.e. Previn / B.A. Examination in case of Hindi; Teacher or in Shorter Examination in case of Sanskrit Teacher.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in H.S. final examination.
- 100 marks on percentage of marks in TET examination; provided that a special TET will be conducted for language teachers comprising of the subjects of Pedagogy and Child Development, Language concerned and General Knowledge.
- 10 marks for NCC certificate (10 marks for "C" certificate and 5 marks for "B" certificate).
- 10 marks for participating in recognized sports at national level representing Assam.
- 10 marks for achievements in the Arts and cultural activities representing the State officially at National level.

N.B. - In all the above mentioned category of teachers, any other marks obtained in any other examinations such as HSLC or equivalent, Graduation / BT or B.Ed. and any other professional qualification not recognized by UGC / NCTE guidelines / Service Rules, to vogue will not be considered.

Other Criteria

- District-wise, Medium-wise, Subject-wise separate Merit Lists will be prepared for each category of the post.
- A candidate must not be less than 18 years of age and not more than 40 years for unreserved category, 45 years for Ex-servicemen, 43 years for OBC / MOBC and 42 years for SC / ST/PS/ST/HS and 40 years for Persons with Disability (PwD) as on 10.08.2022 as per Govt. Office Memorandum No. No. APE-22/16/3, Dated 02/09/2020 and subsequent Corrigendum No. APE-6/2016/52, dttd. 20.02.2021.
- No person having more than two living children or or also DM/2021 from a single or multiple partners shall be eligible for appointment as per the Govt. policy on Small Arched Science and Skill Development Project (Small Arched Science and Skill Development Project) dated 06/11/2019 and No. APE-69/2019/218 dated 16/11/2019.
- No online application will be accepted in this regard.
- The Online Applications and documents submitted by the candidate will be verified with the help of the District Selection Committee (DSC). The District-wise detailed schedule and venue for Screening/ Verification of documents will be notified in the official website. No OPA or other facilities/reservations. District wise verification will be conducted simultaneously on the same date and time in all the districts. The candidates will be informed either individually by the respective Inspector of Schools or collectively by the Director of Secondary Education, Assam in the official website.
- The Online Applications and documents submitted by the candidate will be verified using the facilities with the help of Digit checker, Govt. of India and by scanning through QR Code for ensuring genuineness of the uploaded documents as well as the authenticity of the scanned documents. For the authenticity of the scanned documents, the candidate will be required to upload the original documents for verification at any point of time with proper receipt.
- The candidate must ensure genuineness of all the information/documents uploaded against the application and he/she will be solely responsible for the information/documents uploaded against the online application. Once uploaded the candidate will not be allowed to correct or modify the information/documents submitted by the candidate. Any discrepancy will lead to cancellation of the candidature.
- The candidature will be cancelled forthwith, if any kind of fraudulent/ discrepancy regarding any information / documents uploaded by the candidate is established by appropriate authority at any point of time. The candidate will be delisted from any future recruitment under Government of Assam and subsequent legal action will also be initiated against such candidate.
- A candidate will mention and select the name of the districts for which the application is submitted.
- When the candidates appear for the verification before the DSC they must produce original certificates, testimonials and documents that was uploaded during the application process. Service Rules 2018.
- A candidate for direct recruitment shall be: (a) of sound health both mentally and physically and free organic defect or bodily infirmity which is likely to interfere with the efficient performance of his duties and (b) of sound mental constitution and sound character.
- The Madrasa TET and Special TET for D/AD / Sixth Schedule shall not be considered in the recruitment process of Graduate Teacher (Arts / Hindi / Sanskrit).
- The candidates having NCT CLEAR (NC) status against any qualification will not be eligible to apply.
- There shall be reservation for OBC / MOBC / SC / ST / PS / ST/HS / PwD as per existing Government Rules.

- Candidates with disabilities will have to submit the certificate of disability from the competent authority.
- Certificate - NCC (Only B or C Category only), Sports & Cultural (Recognized state & National Level).

- Experience certificate (if any) of 15 years of teaching experience in undergraduate/junior teacher in provincialized High / Higher Secondary School.
- Experience certificate (if any) (one) year of teaching experience as contractual teacher.
- Experience certificate (if any) (two) years of teaching experience as contractual teacher.
- Experience certificate (if any) of teaching experience for the teachers working continuously on fixed pay basis (other than contractual teachers) in a provincialized Higher Secondary School or High School / Madrasa for their services as fixed pay teachers provided they have requisite academic and professional qualification. As per applicable, if any.
- Certificate of Ex-servicemen issued by the Director, Sainik Welfare Board.

Other Notes

- Candidates should be cautious while submitting the online application as once the application is submitted against a particular Roll Number of TET, they will not be allowed to resubmit any online documents or application for the second time.
- After successful submission of the online form, candidates shall take a print out of the form and submit the same along with self-attested copies of mark-sheets and certificates in support of educational qualification, caste, disability, TET, B.Ed. and occupational activities at the time of document verification before the District Selection Committee. Candidates must also produce original documents that have been uploaded with the online application to the DSC etc.
- After submitting the online application form, the candidates will get a Unique Number against the submitted application and will keep the printout of the Unique Number for all future references.
- Candidates may note that failing to qualify in Screening/ Verification of documents will result cancellation of their candidature.
- The applicant will be responsible for any lapse in submission of online application due to any technical problem.
- Application seeking condonation / relaxation of any criteria should be made to appropriate authority on per applicable norms at least 7 days prior to filing up of online applications.

 - Certificate of Ex-servicemen issued by the Director, Sainik Welfare Board.

Authorities reserve the right to cancel the candidature of any candidate as and when he/she fails to meet the condition if detected.
